

SGN 1 Monitoring tree protection

Always:

- ✓ Use the tree consultant's monitoring schedule
- ✓ Use the tree consultant's monitoring schedule to regularly monitor the tree's health
- ✓ Use the tree consultant to supervise the work in RPAs
- ✓ Monitor damage to roots and disturbance to soil in RPAs
- ✓ Monitor any suspension



SGN 9 Installing/upgrading surfacing in RPAs

Always:

- ✓ Use the tree consultant to supervise the work in RPAs
- ✓ Monitor damage to roots and disturbance to soil in RPAs
- ✓ Monitor any suspension



SGN 2 Fencing protected trees

Always:

- ✓ Install protection before development
- ✓ Make sure protection is fit for purpose, i.e. it prevents damage to trees
- ✓ Keep protection in place until there is no risk to trees
- ✓ Get written permission to move or remove any protection



SGN 10 Installing structures in RPAs

Always:

- ✓ Use the tree consultant to supervise the work in RPAs
- ✓ Monitor damage to roots and disturbance to soil in RPAs
- ✓ Monitor any suspension
